MASTER OF SCIENCE DEGREE: COURSE WORK AND THESIS

- Minimum of two (2) semesters and maximum of six (6) semesters on full-time basis
- . Minimum of four (4) semesters and maximum of eight (8) semesters on part-time basis

DOCTOR OF PHILOSOPHY DEGREE

- · Research and thesis
- Minimum of six (6) semesters and maximum of eight (8) semesters on full-time basis
- . Minimum of eight (8) semesters and maximum of sixteen (16) semesters on part-time basis

ADMISSION INTO THE MASTER'S DEGREE PROGRAMMES

- •The normal minimum entrance requirement for Master of Science shall be a Bachelor's degree from any other recognized University or equivalent institution with at least a second class, second division or equivalent (3.0 GPA, on a 5-point scale) in the relevant field.
- Applicants must include a personal statement of not more than 500 words that explains reasons for applying for the programme. Describe the areas of research that interest you, your career plan and any other information relevant to your application.
- Provide three references (form available under Admissions tab), at least two of these persons should be able to write about your professional/academic ability to undertake graduate studies.

ADMISSION INTO THE DOCTOR OF PHILOSOPHY DEGREE PROGRAMME

- Applicants for PhD programs must have obtained an appropriate Master's Degree (MSc, MA, MEd, MPhil or equivalent) with course work and/ or research.
- Applicants must include a preliminary research proposal.
- Provide three references (form available under Admissions tab), at least two of these persons should be able to write about your professional/academic ability to undertake graduate studies.



Botswana University of Agriculture and Natural Resources (BUAN) wishes to inform all its former students who were previously enrolled in various programmes but were not successful (Fail & Discontinue and Withdrawal) that the University is open for applications for re-admission and re-instatement. In order to qualify for re-admission, students should satisfy all University regulations on Fail and Discontinue (FD) and Withdrawal.

Students who are currently studying with other tertiary institutions, whose programmes articulates with BUAN programmes and wish to transfer to BUAN are also invited to apply. This includes students who are not currently enrolled and they satisfy requirements to enrol back with their institution, they may also apply.

Graduates with Diploma qualifications that articulates with BUAN programmes who may qualify for exemptions in excess of 30 credits may also apply to enrol in the January intake.

Students who were granted their sponsorship for semester 1 2024/2025 but were unable to utilize them, can contact the Academic Services department to get assistance for enrolment in this intake.
